



# HOW TO ACCESS THE PROVIDER REPORT CARD

## → What is the Data Quality Report Card?

The report card analyzes the completeness of key data measurements based on the data being submitted from your facility to VIIS. The completeness of these measures can be used to identify areas of improvement and allows you to see a side-by-side comparison to the state average and AIRA Expectations. The report card is used to assess the overall data quality in VIIS which impacts the accuracy of the system's functionality such as, immunization coverage assessments and patient immunization forecasts.

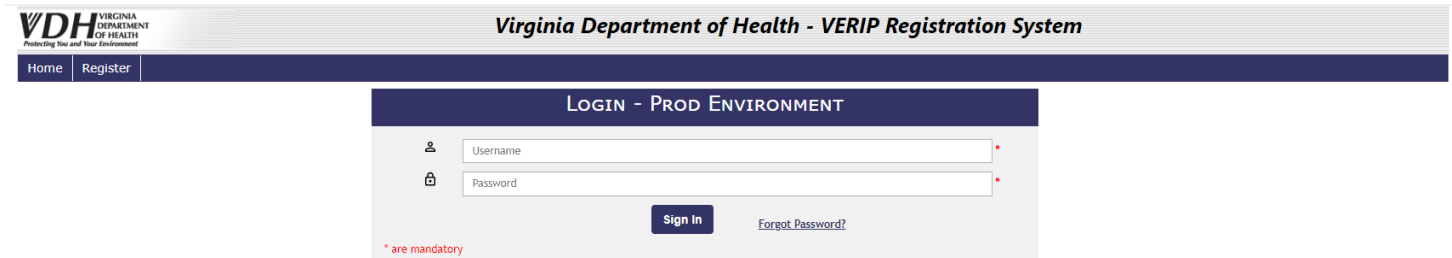
## → Accessing the Report Card:

Report cards are accessible through VERIP (Virginia Electronic Registration for Immunization Programs). You must have a [VERIP login](#) that is linked to the existing practice account.

### STEP 1:

Login to your VERIP account. You can also find our Report Card FAQ in the yellow box labelled "Guidance Documents" on the home page.

**\*Note: creating a new VERIP account will not automatically give you access to your location's report card. The user account must be linked to the existing organization account through VDH. We encourage you to work with your location's existing "VERIP User", who can export a copy from the system to share.**
