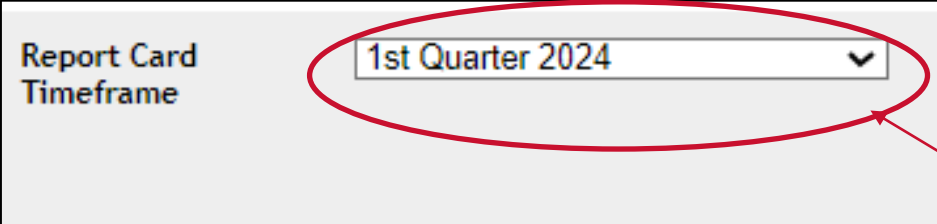

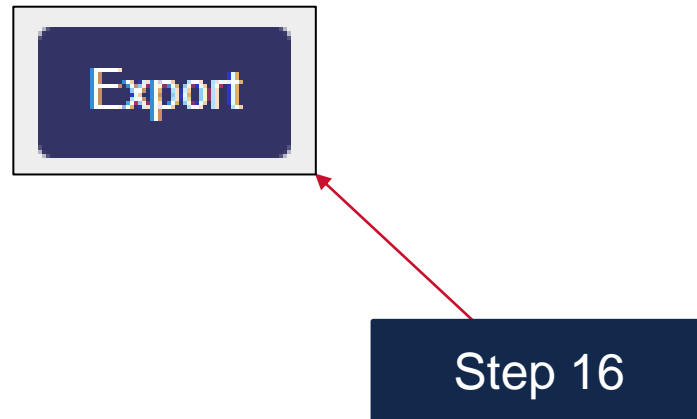

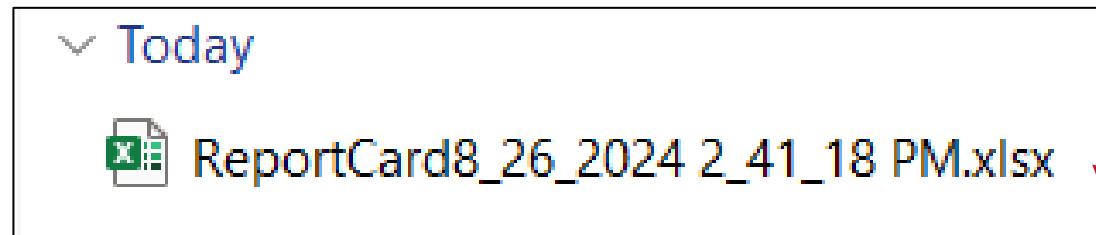
Select the Export button to export your Report Card as an Excel document.
